THE MILESTONES

1919 The Far Eastern College School of Accounts, Commerce and Finance was founded by the late Don Vicente Fabella, the first Filipino Certified Public Accountant.

1922 The college changed its name to José Rizal College as homage to our national hero and patriot, Dr. José P. Rizal.

1932 José Rizal College became a founding member of the Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities (PACU).

1942 - 1945 José Rizal College closed as a sign of protest during the Japanese occupation of the Philippines in World War II. It re-opened after the war in 1945.

1950 José Rizal College transferred to its present site at 80 Shaw Boulevard, Mandaluyong City.

1962 José Rizal College became a founding member of the Philippine Association of Collegiate Schools of Business (PACSB).

1974 José Rizal College became a founding member of the Private Education Retirement Annuity Association (PERAA).

1997 José Rizal College became a founding member of the Association of Personnel Management in Private Schools (PAPMIPS).

1999 José Rizal College received Level III Accreditation from the Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities Commision on Accreditation (PACUCOA).

2000 José Rizal College granted University Status by the Commision on Higher Education (CHED) and has since been known as José Rizal University.

2001 José Rizal University was granted Autonomous Status by CHED.

2005 José Rizal University's Bachelor in Elementary Education Program was granted Level III Accreditation Status by PACUCOA.

2009 José Rizal University's Business Administration program received Level IV Accreditation from PACUCOA and was awarded CHED Center of Development status.

The Junior High School offers the four-year secondary curriculum as approved by the Department of Education (DepEd) and Level III accredited by Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities Commission on Accreditation (PACUCOA), and modified to suit the global educational policies and priorities of JRU Junior High School. Junior High School classes are conducted for 80 minutes each for English, Math, Science and Business Technology 3 and 4 and 40 minutes each for the rest of other subjects.

English is used as the medium of instruction in all subjects except Filipino. It is the University's belief that complete familiarity with the English language is critical to a more effective social and economic role of the child. The Junior High School is very conscious of the importance of a good command of the English language in secondary education and has taken the option of shortening the four years of Character Education into the first two years and devoting the class time saved into additional English subjects. In addition, the Junior High School Division initiated steps in improving our subjects by including the Technology Enabled Materials (TEM) in teaching all our subjects.






ENTERTAINMENT AND MULTIMEDIA COMPUTING

La Pluma Scholarship

The batch should consist of at least 100 graduating students in the Elementary and Junior High School; and at least 80 graduating students in the Senior High School in any CHED recognized and accredited schools.

The JRU Law School has an outstanding complement of professors that make up the law faculty. It is dominated by members of the judiciary, but also include professionals from various undertakings: Bar reviewers, trial lawyers, corporate practitioners, businessmen, book authors and professional academicians.

Hello, and welcome back to Jose Rizal University!

We've been online for the past two years, and now are re-opening our campus to welcome you back. Much has happened, even if the campus has been physically silent. We've embraced the online environment, faculty have trained hard, and we've investment in content and the equipment needed to get you students through what will be the learning classrooms of the future.

To this end, we have converted almost all our classrooms, from Grade 1 to the Graduate School, to hyflex classrooms. Safety continues to be our priority, and these classroom conversions (and the entire campus) and our protocols are of course compliant with the requirements of the Department of Health, the Department of Education, and the Commission on Higher Education.

Hyflex is a style of hybrid learning that allows faculty and students to learn face-to-face (inside the classroom) and online at the same time. Many educators have felt that hyflex is the method of delivery for the future, and we think so too. The COVID pandemic has shown that online learning has its promises and potentials, but so too does traditional face-to-face learning. The best learning environments of the future will need both, in terms of classrooms and teachers ready to run in these environments - and JRU has these for you!

JRU is now a 3-star university, rated by Quacquarelli Symonds, one of the top international raters of quality education, and a sign of the international caliber of a Rizalian education. Few Philippine universities have this accolade, so much that we have been recently recognized by the Commission on Higher Education for this achievement. This sits well with our other quality achievements, including FAAP accreditation for our graduate, college and basic education programs, ISO, autonomous and center of excellence recognition, and students placing in PRC exams.

We've also opened the Centennial Building - nine and a half floors of learning at the center of the campus - which we commenced as part of our 100th year celebration in 2019. The top one and a half floors will house a state-of-the-art performance theater that sets 500, which we expect to finish this second semester. The Centennial Building itself houses classrooms, numerous student areas, an expanded eating center, and a re-imagined library on the fifth floor, called the Learning Commons. The Learning Commons is especially worth visiting, as it incorporates an understanding of the library as an information commons (information, in all its forms) - the new international model for libraries. The second floor has a wonderful open area for students looking out on the quadrangle, surely one of the best views in the city.

JRU also welcomes the College of Criminal Justice Education, which houses our Bachelor of Science in Criminology degree. The conversion of criminology from a program to a college is our commitment to this exciting discipline. The College of CJE will complement our other colleges – BAA (Business Administration and Accountancy), CSE (Computer Science and Engineering), NHS (Nursing and the Health Sciences), HTM (Hotel and Tourism Management), and EAS (Education, Arts and Sciences) – each a fantastic home of learning for you, the future leaders of this country.

The Elementary School, the Junior High School and the Senior High School have also been busy preparing for the reopening. All schools have converted likewise to hyflex, making them probably among the very few nationwide with hyflex capabilities. Our teachers in each school – already known for their experience in expertise in learning – have undergone (and many time, have demanded more!) the specialized training to deliver hyflex learning. This is particularly impressive for the Elementary School, which less than a year ago was a full-fledged mega-vaccination site for the city, part of our continued commitment to fight the virus.

The Law School and the Graduate School equally welcome you. It is never too early to think about what you might do after college, and making a graduate degree (Master, Doctor and Juris Doctor) part of those plans is a good step. Our graduate programs continue to be excellent – with top-shelf accreditations and consistent bar performance surpassing the national averages – and are great homes for the highest levels of education in the country.

The Graduate and Law Schools are primarily online, but face-to-face classes are also available. The main focus on online delivery reflects both faculty recommendations, and the request of many working students who have found our online delivery a great experience.

Lastly, we are introducing a new tagline, "Find Your Inner Hero" as part of the post-pandemic, next-100 year's brand of JRU, "Husay Rizal" Husay Rizal (composed of Talinong Rizal, Talentong Rizal, Taos-Pusong Rizal and Tatag Rizal challenges) reflects the excellence of our national hero and the University, and challenges our faculty and students to become their best selves – their own heroes – because that is what our communities and society need.

Much is new, and exciting for all of you, returning students and new students! We need to remind everyone that at the core of all these opportunities are the guiding principles of the university: our Mission, our Vision and our Core Values (look them up at jru.edu!). We want the next 100 years to be amazingly better than the last, and we want each of you to take us all there.
